- 1- The Baptism of Jesus
- 2- Christ's Self Manifestation at Cana
- 3- Christ's Proclamation of the Kingdom of God
- 4- The Transfiguration of Our Lord
- 5- Christ's Institution of the Eucharist

Sorrowful

- 1- The agony of Jesus in the Garden
- 2- The Scourging of Jesus at the pillar
- 3- The Crowning of Jesus with Thorns
- 4- Jesus Carries His Heavy Cross
- 5- The Crucifixion and Death of Jesus

Glorious

- 1- The Resurrection of Jesus
- 2- The Ascension of Jesus into Heaven
- 3- The Decent of the Holy Spirit
- 4- Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary
- 5- Crowning of the blessed Virgin Mary

How to say the Rosary

- 1- Begin on the crucifix and say the Apostles' Creed
- 2- On the first bead, say I Our Father
- 3- On the next 3 beads, say Hail Mary
- 4- Next say I Glory Be. Then announce and think of the first Mystery and say I Our Father
- 5- Say 10 Hail Mary and I Glory be to the Father.
- 6- Announce the second Mystery and continue in the same way until each of the five Mysteries of the selected group or decades is said
- 7- Finish with the Hail Holy Queen and the prayer to Saint Michael and the Sign of the Cross.
