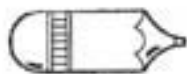


My Lenten Resolution Egg

Ash Wednesday is the first day of Lent. During Lent, we try to do something to make ourselves better and our world a better place. We call a promise to try to do better a *resolution*.



Decide on one thing you will do this Lent to improve yourself or your world. This is your resolution. Write it on the egg, then color the egg light purple. (Purple is the color for Lent.)

Cut out your egg and paste it onto a heavy piece of colored paper. Cut around the edge of the egg so that you have a sturdy "Lenten egg." Hang it at home where you can see it every day.

Every Sunday during Lent, think back on your week and decide how well you did with your resolution. Check the box that best describes your efforts.

Bring your egg to your last class before Easter. Look at your results. Then trace around your egg on a pretty piece of paper and cut out a new "Easter" egg. Paste this one over your Lenten egg. Decorate your Easter egg any way you like. Poke a hole near the top of your egg and pull a ribbon through it to serve as a hanger. Display your egg on your class bulletin board or at home to remind you how you tried to improve yourself or the world and prepare for Easter.
